Halloween Safety Tips

Halloween is an exciting time for kids and their parents and we want everyone to be safe while they are out having fun! Please take a look at the tips below for the safety of our trick-or-treaters and anyone who may be on the road during prime candy hours.

Trick-or-Treaters:

- ~Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and cross walks.
- ~ Keep eyes up and open for oncoming traffic.
- ~Walk, don't run, across streets.
- \sim Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers. If possible, choose light colors for costumes.
- \sim Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.

Drivers:

- ~ Popular trick-or-treating hours are 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. so be especially alert for kids during those hours.
- ${\sim} Take$ extra time to look for kids at intersections, on medians, and on curbs.
- ~Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully.
- ~Eliminate any distractions inside your car so you can concentrate on the road and the surroundings.
