A New Year needs a new Start! Here is a quick review of the rules and regulations for Redstone Family Housing. Please feel free to stop in the office for a copy of the Resident Handbook going over all this information.

- 1) Do not submit emergency maintenance requests online! Always call to ensure we can respond in a timely manner. For after hours emergency calls, please use **855-627-3932**.
- 2) Travel trailers, motor coaches, cargo trailers, camper bodies, camper trailers, commercial vehicles, tractor trailers, oversized boats, and horse/live stock trailers may not be permanently parked, or stored on the street, driveways, yards, or parking lots in any housing area.
- 3) Rent is due the 1st of every month regardless of holidays. We have a rent drop box outside of the office, and residents can also make payments on rentpayment.com
- 4) Pest control is on an as-needed basis. If you are having any problems in your home please be sure to notify us as soon as possible by phone or email so we can resolve the issue as soon as possible.
