Winter Prep!

Winter is right around the corner below are some nifty home and car tips so you can begin your winter preparation and stay warm!

- 1) Stay dry. Wet clothing loses all of its insulating value and transmits the cold rapidly.
- 2) Clean out the gutters, disconnect and drain all outside hoses. If possible, shut off outside water valves.
- During cold spells, keep cabinet doors open to allow warm air to circulate around pipes, particularly those in the kitchen and bathrooms.
- 4) Top off antifreeze, windshield wiper fluid, gas, oil and other fluids.
- 5) Keep bagged salt or sand in the trunk for extra traction and to melt ice.
- 6) Make sure your tires have enough tread. Consider snow tires.
- 7) If you have a fireplace, keep the flue closed when you're not using it.
- 8) Keep a slow trickle of water flowing through faucets connected to pipes that run through unheated or unprotected spaces.
