Alterations to Landscaping Policy from Resident Handbook

Residents must obtain written permission from REDSTONE FAMILY HOUSING prior to starting any alteration or modification to the grounds around their home. This includes, but is not limited to modifications to the landscaping, patios and walkways, fencing, or installing shrubbery, or flowers. All non-standard garden areas installed by Residents must be returned to their original condition prior to termination of occupancy. This includes the installation of sod in all areas that have been altered. Any new sod must be of the same variety and species as the surrounding area. 
